He was singing all those songs word for word. He had short term memory loss but he remembered that fishing trip. He wanted me to take him back before it got winter and I had full intentions on doing that but he passed away. Now Barry is fishing in Heaven. I have taken care of many people over the years. Barry has hurt me the most. The elderly I took care of were sick. Barry did not appear to be sick. He was in a wheel chair yet he was happy because he could still go places. His biggest worry was what he was going to eat or snack next. Had I known he was going to pass away I would have fed him anything his little heart desired that day. He confused me on a daily basis. He would ask me what day it was and I would have to think. On Friday I said dang Barry you look like you are nine months pregnant and your stomach is so hard. He said look at me. I did. He stuck his tongue out at me and laughed. We would watch the game shows and he knew all the answers and he would say how dumb the people were. LOL. I don't know what I am going to do without him to take care of. He was such a joy always happy and always laughing. We had some of the best times together. I don't know which one of us loved each other the most. It's probably a close tie. I have questioned God even though I know I am not supposed to. The only logical answer I can come up with is when he coded and they had to bring him back he was out for 25 minutes. Maybe he had more brain injury and would not be Barry again and he would have to end up in a nursing home. Kim would never have wanted to do that and he would never have wanted to go there. I don't know but I know my God is real and He won't put no more on you than you can bear. God could have stopped it all but He had His reason not to. He needed Barry for something. I will never understand why and I will always wonder if. To know Barry was to love him. He is going to be missed oh so much.

His last words to me were have a good weekend and I will see you Monday.
